

Local Resident Killed in Anzac Day Collision

Mr. Richard Henry Edwards, a well-known resident of Sunshine, was one of three persons killed in a collision between two motor cars on the Calder Highway, near Diggers' Rest, on Anzac night.

The deceased, who was the son of Mrs. Larcombe, of Couch St., leaves a wife and two children to mourn their loss. The funeral, which was largely attended, took place to the Footscray Cemetery on Monday last.

The late Mr. Edwards was connected with the motoring trade in Melbourne, and was highly esteemed in business circles. The Rev. R. F. Adams, of St. Mark's Church of England, Sunshine, conducted the services at the house and graveside, and also read the Masonic service. Walter A. Warne, of Footscray, had charge of the funeral arrangements.
