Whilst employed with the Textile Engineering Company of Wellington Street, Collingwood, Mr. William Vernon King was struck by a girder last Friday and fatally injured. He was 32 years of age.

The late Mr. King was the son of Mrs. Lily King of King Edward Avenue, Sunshine and the late Mr. Ray King, formerly of Brunswick.

He was extremely popular with his workmates and the funeral on Tuesday was largely attended.

The deceased was a brother-in-law of Mr. H. V. Priest, of the Hotel Derrimut, Sunshine. He leaves a widow and two young children to mourn their sad loss.

His brother, Denzil, resides with his mother in King Edward Avenue.
