

#### RAILWAY CROSSING ACCIDENT.

A railway crossing accident occurred at Sunshine early yesterday morning, as the result of which Arthur Thomas Gore, a married man, with five children, who had been employed at the Mount Lveil Manure Works, at Yarraville, was killed. Deceased set out in a conveyance for Victoria Market to purchase vegetables for his wife, who carries on a fruit business in Anderson street, Sunshine, and when crossing the railway line at Anderson street, was apparently run down by the newspaper train which leaves Spencer street for Bendigo at 2.10 a.m. The night being very dark, the crew of the train were unaware of the accident until arriving at Sunbury, where Gore's body was found lying on the front of the engine. The Sunbury police found in his clothes documents bearing his name, and subsequently established his identity through the Sunshine police. Deceased's neck was broken. The vehicle was smashed to matchwood and the horse killed.

The body was removed to the Morgue and the Coroner notified.
