

## Six People Drown In Victoria

MELBOURNE. Sunday.—At least six people were drowned in Victoria at the week-end.

John William Armstead, 24 painter, of Manangatang, was drowned yesterday while swimming in the Murray at Robinvale, near Mildura.

His body has not been recovered.

The boy was drowned today while swimming with several other children in Gunblower's Creek, near his home.

He was Patrick Stephen O'Brien, of Koondrook.

Police dragged the creek and found the body in 20 feet of water.

Virgil State, 28, of Raleigh-road, Maribyrnong, was drowned in the Maribyrnong River today. He was diving, and failed to reappear. Dragging operations have been suspended till to-morrow.

### Unsuccessful

Romano Reglioni, 25, an Italian, of High-street, Wodonga, was drowned in the Wodonga Creek this afternoon. Police dragged the creek without success.

Another Italian, believed to be Enzo Giantonio, 20, of Gore-street, Fitzroy, was drowned in Coburg Lake today.

His body has not been found.

Martin Daniel Hanrahan, 19, of Pyramid Hill, was drowned in a swimming pool this afternoon. He got out of his depth.
