

**SUPPOSED SUICIDE OF A MAN.**

The other fatality occurred near Braybrook Junction station late on Thursday night. Constables Dillon and Weddell, of the Footscray police, being informed that a man was lying dead on the line close to the Braybrook Junction, proceeded to the locality, and found the dead man on the line, the body being cut almost in two. The Braybrook station master stated that the man was at that station waiting for the 7.59 train, but having no money to buy a ticket one was given to him. He saw nothing more of the deceased until the body was discovered, but from the demeanor of the man previously it is supposed he committed suicide. The deceased was a man about 5 feet 3 inches in height, of medium build and fair complexion, and a number of discharges found in his pocket indicate he was a seaman named Thomas Strachan or Thomas Brewster. An inquest will be held.
