Pavilion Destroyed by Fire

The pavilion in the old football ground, together with a quantity of cricketing gear, that had been stored there after the completion of Saturday's matches, was destroyed by fire at 10.25 o'clock on Sunday night. The fire began in the rear portion of the umpire's room, the door of which had been damaged some time before, and spread so rapidly that the brigade could do little on arrival. An insurance of £40 was on the shed, which had been erected by voluntary labor. The cricketing material was owned by the Diggers and by a Prahran team. The police are making enquiries into the origin of the fire. About three years back another shed on this ground was burnt down.
