CAR OVERTURNS NEAR BRAYBROOK

WOMAN FATALLY INJURED

Melbourne, Dec. 9. Falling under a motor car when it overturned on the Ballarat road near Braybrook late this afternoon a woman was so severely gashed on the head by broken glass that she died on the way to the hospital. Five other passengers escaped with minor injuries. The names of the victims are:—Killed: Mrs. Florence Temple, aged about 40, of Temple Court Hotel, Queen-street, city. Injured: Margaret O'Connor, aged 39, of the Albion Hotel, Northcote, cuts and bruises; D. J. O'Conpor, same address, abrasions; Marie, Henry, aged 20, same address. shock and bruises; Reginald Temple, aged about 43, licensee of the Temple Hotel, cuts and sions.

The car driven by D. J. O'Connor was travelling at about 30 miles an hour when a back tyre blew out and the car overturned. Most of the passengers were thrown out, but Mrs. Temple fell on a piece of jagged glass from the windscreen, which inflicted a deep gash in her face. It is believed that death was

due to loss of blood.
