"Flying Rock" Victim Identified

An elderly man living in a humpy near Berkshire Road, believed to have been killed last week by a flying rock from a nearby quarry blast, was identified yesterday as William Lowe, although his real name is believed to be Lown.

Police officials, including Sen. Const. Tom Daly and First Const. Charles Cumming, of Sunshine, believe Lowe met his death when a large rock hurtled through the air after a quarry blast, burst through the flimsy roof of his home and struck him in the head.

The dead man came from England and may have a son living in Sydney or Melbourne. Information to confirm this will be welcomed by police.
