

MOTOR CYCLIST KILLED.

THROWN UNDER WHEEL OF VAN.

Fatality at Sunshine.

Owing to his motor cycle skidding as he attempted to pass between a van and three persons, who were walking along Ballarat-road, Sunshine, about 300 yards on the west side of the Albion railway gates, yesterday morning, George Henry Hartley, 35 years, married, of Leonard-street, Sunshine, was thrown under the rear wheel of the van, and was instantly killed. The van contained about twenty workers, who were travelling from Footscray to a leather works at Deer Park, where Hartley was employed as foreman. The body was removed to the City Morgue by the Sunshine police.
