SMALL FIRE IN SUN CRESCENT

Fire, the origin of which has not been determined, destroyed on Thursday morning an outhouse and damaged a small bit of fencing at the rear of the premises in Sun crescent formerly occupied by Hector Flockhart as a butcher's shop. The loss is covered by insurance.

As soon as the alarm was given the "Advocate" bucket brigade, the members of which are exercised at strictly irregular intervals, rallied, each man in his appointed place, and assisted by a hose from the Hotel Derrimut, kept the flames from spreading. When the Fire Brigade arrived the last dying embers were being extinguished by the hose discharge.
