Sunshine Men Killed in Road Accidents

In a road accident near Seymour on Friday last, Mr. Robert John Hanson, of 58 Westmoreland Road, Sunshine, lost his life. He leaves a wife and infant daughter.

The late Mr. Hanson, whose family came from Bacchus Marsh, played football with Braybrook and Sunshine Colts. His wife, formerly Grace Banks, comes from a family well known in Sunshine. Mr. Hanson's mother is an active worker for St. Mary's Church of England and Sunshine C.W.A., and his father is an employee of I.C.I., Deer Park.

On Saturday night, Mr. Trevan Keith Trezise, 21, of Devonshire Road, Sunshine, was killed instantly when the car he was driving ran off the Hume Highway and struck a tree near the 51-mile post.

The late Mr. Trezise was a member of the State Electricity Commission and was stationed at Nagambie. Members of his family are well-known Sunshine residents.
