

Road death of traffic constable

Constable Alexander P. Wynd, 26, of Second av., Sunshine, was fatally injured when his motor-cycle and a panel van collided in Hopkins st., Footscray, last night.

Wynd was dragged under the van with his cycle for 62 feet, and was dead on arrival at Royal Melbourne Hospital.

Constable Wynd was a member of Russell st. traffic control branch, but was riding his own cycle home.

A man was killed and his brother injured last night, when a tyre on a car in which they were travelling blew out, and the car and a truck collided, in Matthew av., near Kellor rd., Essendon.

They were Norman Howard, 26, of Gould st., Frankston, who was killed instantly when the car overturned and his brother, John, 20, of the same address, a passenger in the car, who received head injuries and concussion, and was detained at Royal Melbourne Hospital for observation.
