Brother, Sister Die in Ballarat-rd. Accident

An 18-year-old girl and her nine-year-old brother both died after being struck by a car in Ballarat Road, Braybrook on Saturday evening.

The accident occurred near Darnley Street about 7 p.m. and Sunshine police would appreciate the co-operation of any eye-witness or anyone who may have been at the scene after the accident to help complete investigations.

The two young people were Glenda Olsen and Jeffery Olsen, both of 35 Shepherd Street, Braybrook. Jeffery was dead on arrival at Footscray Hospital and Glenda died shortly after arrival.

The car which struck them was driven by Eric V. Corfield of 144 Phoenix Street, North Sunshine.

Constables G. Richards and C. Ware of Sunshine, investigated.
