

*RIDING FATALITY AT DEER PARK.*

Dr. Youl, the City Coroner, held an inquest at the Melbourne Hospital yesterday on the body of Thomas Gill, aged 36 years, who died on Tuesday last at that institution from the effects of a fall from a horse. Evidence was tendered which showed that the deceased was riding in Deer Park on the evening of 31st March, when it was supposed he rode into a tree guard and received a heavy fall. The deceased was found next morning lying near the tree guard, which was badly damaged, and the horse was found four miles away. When the deceased was taken to the hospital it was ascertained that he had sustained a fracture of the skull, from the effects of which he died. A verdict of accidental death was returned.
