THE FATAL GUN ACCIDENT AT ST. ALBANS.

Mr. W. M. Clark, J.P., held a magisterial inquiry at the Footsuray Court house on Friday afternoon touching the death of J. B. Burrowa (second son of Mr. J. G. Burrowa, chief reader of The Argus staff), who was found dead the previous day near the 13-mile post gates, St. Albans, on the Mount Alexander railway line.

The magistrate found a verdict to the effect that the young man accidentally shot him-self whilst getting through the fence drag-ging his gan after him.
