

THE BRAYBROOK FATALITY.

CAUSE OF DEATH—TYPHOID.

Dr Anderson has made a post-mortem examination on the body of Margaret Roberts, of Braybrook, who died from some obscure cause during last week. The examination showed death to be due to typhoid, from which the whole family were suffering in a greater or less degree. He believes it possible that some fruit eaten by two or three of the patients may have accelerated the progress of the disease. An inquest has been dispensed with.
