Thomas Cahill's house destroyed by fire

An inquest was held on Tuesday, by Mr. Candler, at Keilor, upon the cause of a fire which occurred on the night of the 21st inst., at the dwellinghouse of Thomas Cahill, farmer. The place was quite destroyed, and Mr. Cahill estimated the damage at £500. It was only with difficulty that his wife and family escaped from the burning premises. The jury found that the fire arose accidentally.
