

THE BRAYBROOK RAILWAY FATALITY.

The body of the aged woman found yesterday near Sydneyham, is, in all probability, that of Mary Goodwin, a widow, aged 87, who has for some seven months been residing with her married daughter, Mrs England, of Moreland road west, Coburg. She left home at half-past 8 the day previous to her death, and had then in her possession two sovereigns. Mrs England identifies the clothes as that of her mother's. She does not understand how she happened to get where found. For some time she had been an out-patient at the Melbourne Hospital, and recently paid a visit to Queensland, where she has two sons and a daughter. She has been a widow seven months.
